



**Request for Qualifications  
Artists/Instructors Needed for Workshops related to the exhibition:  
*Where The Wild Things Are: Maurice Sendak in His Own Words*  
June 11 – August 30, 2010  
Scottsdale Civic Center Library**

Scottsdale Public Art (SPA) in association with the Scottsdale Public Library will be conducting artist led workshops for teens for the upcoming exhibition *Where The Wild Things Are: Maurice Sendak in His Own Words* that will run from June 11, 2010 until August 30, 2010.

The interactive exhibition will be appealing to all ages. SPA and the library will sponsor numerous themed activities and educational programs based on Sendak's books, such as *In The Night Kitchen*, *Chicken Soup With Rice*, and the very popular classic *Where The Wild Things Are*.

Scottsdale Public Art is seeking artists/instructors to develop workshops for teens to teach them to illustrate in the style of Sendak. A site that might be helpful, showing work by various artists inspired by Sendak is: [www.TerribleYellowEyes.com](http://www.TerribleYellowEyes.com).

Interested artists/instructors should submit the following:

- Biographical statement and/or resume listing your training, artistic experience, and/or applicable teaching and/or other related experience.
- Up to 5 examples of your artwork submitted in JPEG file format and/or up to 5 printed images of your work (individual images should not to exceed 8.5 in x 11 format).
- A brief narrative description of your idea(s) for a workshop, including the duration and scope of the workshop (e.g. a one hour workshop to create your own *Wild Thing*; Weekend Workshop to create Sendak inspired mini-book—three two hour workshops on consecutive days). Include a description of your teaching method and any special supply or set up needs.
- A statement of your teaching availability (dates and times you can teach) between June 11 – August 30, 2010.

The format, duration, and number of workshops have yet to be determined. Artists will be paid an all inclusive fee. Fee will be determined based upon scope and duration of workshop. The workshops may be several short single classes or several workshops with more serious students. Dates and times of workshops will be determined after the submittal project based upon artist/instructor availability.
