



Since 1985, the Scottsdale Public Art Program has envisioned the 184-square mile city as an outdoor gallery where art is an everyday encounter for residents and visitors. The program has completed 68 permanent and 21 temporary artworks that encompass a wide range of artistic expressions, creating a diverse collection — from the traditional to the contemporary; from stand-alone objects to artist-designed walls and parks; and as unconventional as giant inflatables and cast Jell-o constructions of our city's landmarks. Scottsdale has the second longest running program in the state with one of the few Art in Private Development ordinances nationwide, through which 86 artworks have been completed to date.
